



## STAINLESS STEEL CARE & CLEANING GUIDE

Stainless steel is used for its resistance to corrosion. However, as with any outdoor items, stainless steel furniture requires regular maintenance to keep looking new.

Although stainless steel is generally resistant to corrosion, the surface can experience discoloration by the effects of salt water and/or chlorinated water. This may result in small brown spots appearing on its surface (especially in coastal areas).

These spots do not affect the strength or integrity of the furniture. They are superficial discolorations that require cleaning to restore the stainless steel to its original appearance.

To preserve the finish, we recommend cleaning regularly and applying anti-corrosion protection 1 to 2 times a year, especially if used near the ocean or pool.

### CLEANING

Brown spots may appear on the stainless steel, but they can be easily cleaned by gently rubbing the surface of the steel in the direction of the grain.

1. Please use protective gloves and eye protection for your safety.
2. Cover the ground under your working area before cleaning.
3. Follow the instruction on the cleaner/polisher of your choice.
4. Gently rub the surface of the steel, in the direction of the grain with a soft cloth and buff with dry cloth to a shine.

### PROTECTING

Apply anti-corrosion protectant 1-2 times a year to prevent elements from attaching to the surface and prolong the finish.

1. Please use protective gloves and eye protection for your safety.
2. Cover the ground under your working area before cleaning.
3. Follow the instructions on the protectant of your choice.
